WHEN DID YOU DISCOVER THE SAMPLER?

about a month before the infamous spanish holiday, about May of 1988, i was fascinated with Public Enemy and the idea behind The Young Gods. i saw this incredibly cheap sampler for about £100 was one of those pedals thats meant to be an echo pedal but is made into a sampler as well, Jerry had been given a drum machine and he leant it to me, i started messing with the two, it set my imagination off, I had started writing songs about a month before and, and it came together on the holiday because i had been messing about with this stuff in the first place that we got started.

as long as you use imagination then you're away. the way we made Info Freako was terrible, it was before we could afford decent samplers, it was all recording up tapes then sampling them and trying to get it all in.

i listened to the master tape of 'Info Freako' the other day, the way in which we had recorded it was hilarious, really badly done. Whats so exciting about that record is that you can hear the imagination at work on it, that kind of mental energy, that sounds like a load of hippyshit, but it absorbed into the record you can feel something. you could have a cabaret band covering it, it wouldn't sound good, its not the kind of thing that they could play, they couldn't put the energy into it to make it work.

do i like this kind of rock sugar, its really very pretty, i dont actually want to eat sugar but it just says "eat me".

WHAT IS THE CRAPIEST HAIRSTYLE YOU'VE EVER HAD?

The one i have at the moment, its a constant one, the reason i always wear hats is because i have such a crap hairstyle. I blame it entirely on my mother, i had this prehistoric hairline for a start, and i have hair that you can do absolutely nothing with, it always looks crap whatever you do. Hats are the obvious thing, its a bit of a cowardly retreat, i admit but i feel particularly afflicted.

### DID YOU DO WELL AT SCHOOL?

I met Gen at school in 1979, he came into the same year as us, and I think every body used to pick on him, hence his nickname (which has become his name), but I wont go into detail because he wont like me. Alan - I met through a mutual friend, I wanted a bass player, and he said "well I know someone who plays bass" Jerry we got through a musicians wanted ad in Melody Maker, which is the worse way possible, it so cold, besides which, you can end up with a real pile of crap like Jerry, ...no he's been good on this tour, I must go over that and say Jerry has performed particularly well on this tour. Iain I met through skating which I must say is a good way to meet someone. I was drinking in this pub in London and I was starting at the ground I saw this pair of Viston streetwear shoes, no one at that time wore them apart from skaters, so it was instantly "Where do you go skating?". We used to go out skating at weekends, and when we needed a sample player we got him in.

### HOW DID YOU MEET THE REST OF THE BAND?

I dont really have any, I dispair at my dress sense and dispair of a lot of things, there are very little of my clothes for which I knackered now, I like them. No, theres very little I like.

Congleton Town Hall will be filled with the fund-raising sounds of young Kenny Webster's organ music next Friday as he tries to raise enough money to buy a fourth guide dog.

Inspired by the plight of a blind man some years ago, 15-years-old Kenny, of Ashbourne, began to put his musical talent to good use and started to raise money for the Guide Dogs for the Blind.

Up to now, through various concerts, he has raised more than £3,000, and with the Congleton concert, on 23rd August, he hopes to boost his total even further.

Kind-hearted Kenny has been playing the organ since the age of 11 and his repertoire ranges from classical to pop music.

His fund-raising began when he was touched by the difficulties of a blind man who was attempting to cross a busy road, when no cars would stop for him.

Asking his father to stop his van, Kenny got out and helped the man to negotiate the highway, and decided that he would help to raise money to provide the caring canine eyes that so many blind people rely upon.

The Congleton concert begins at 7.30 p.m.

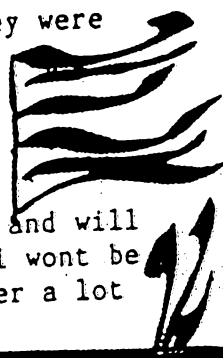


BLUR

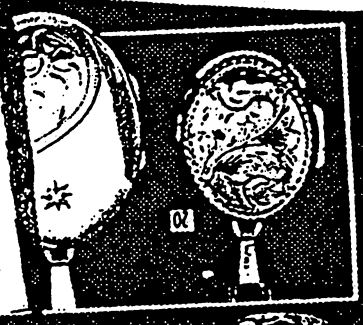
Alex: We've tried to finish Schuberts symphony for him but...

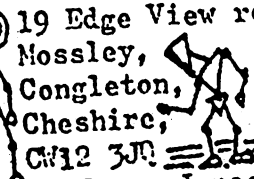

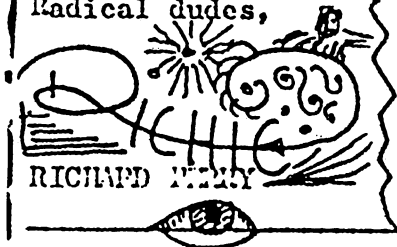
