out writing a day in the 'life' piece I'd thought yeah that  
shouldn't be too difficult and would to present a finished piece as  
early as possible. (Honest!) However, as the tour progressed I  
completely forgot about it and it was only the fact that Richard called  
a fortnight later that I am now writing anything at all - Damn  
to think I almost got away with it too. AARGH!!

Anyway seeing as how I was asked to do this whilst on  
tour I shall write about a typical day on tour - far more interesting than  
at home: read on -----

Depending on how far we have to travel, we're usually up  
10am. If we have a particularly long journey then it's earlier and  
if you want to make it for breakfast at whichever hotel it is we're  
you have to be up in good time. Breakfasts usually finish by 9am  
& it's a Sunday when it goes on until 9.30 wow! Anyway I  
usually pass on hotel breakfasts in favour of buying some fruit instead - I  
stand fried food in the morning Yuck! When we have to leave, our tour  
organiser, Gino, calls each room usually with some time to spare to tell  
you <sup>to be</sup> ready in the reception in 10 minutes or whatever. All the things  
in we load the van up and depart. Everyone has their favourite seat  
in the bus - mine is the front passenger seat although I do drive  
sometimes, Mike likes to sit just behind the driver and usually travels  
with his walkman or working out our next hit hal hal. Iain sits  
next to me either reading Stephen King's latest or growing out to the latest  
on his walkman; Alan is behind Mike and Jerry at the back.  
Both sleep a lot when we travel mainly because they are the  
most party animals and have inevitably only had a few hours sleep.  
Jerry likes to see where we're going and joke around with Gino  
I usually navigate (not usually necessary in England as we now know  
of the towns but in Europe that can be a bit of fun!) Excusez-moi  
or etc. ou est le village?

After a few hours it's lunch time and time to stop at  
truck ~~...~~ AARGH!!



D) these places! If they're not full of American tourists dressed hideously and staring at each other it's full of dithering idiots who wander aimlessly about getting in everyone's way; plus of course they are f\*\*\*ing expensive! Gimpo is the master of queue-barging and eating food before paying for any of it so let's just say some of us have benefitted from his experience and we usually get through pretty quickly. Then there's usually 10 minutes or so to hit the video games - usually Iain and I and then a quick raid on the shop before heading off again. If we make good time we go to the hotel before soundcheck to check in, dump our bags off and maybe chill out for 1/2 an hour or so before Gimpo calls us to soundcheck - the crew have been there all day setting up so when we arrive we just check individual instruments (except) which in the case of a drunk kit can take a while and bores the crap out of everyone while I sit there hitting one drum at a time for about 30 mins (and it ~~is~~ ~~is~~) so it sounds just A.E. Then, when everyone has done their own thing we whack through a couple of numbers (usually 3): ones which have all the variable ~~James Jones~~ James Jones sounds in them, ones with loads of backing vocals etc etc. to make sure that it all sounds good out front and on stage and that's food time at about 3.30/6-ish. This time out we were lucky enough to have caterers of what a treat. A really fabulous 3 course meal each night for band & crew and a chance to catch up on all the gossip & jokes around with everyone - it's quite a family thing & great fun.

After food the band go back to the hotel for a few hours: watch T.V., write postcards, take a bath you know, all the exciting stuff and then it's back to the gig usually about 45 minutes before we're due to go on stage. Mike likes plenty of time to get his voice warmed up and sing with an acoustic guitar backstage - sometimes we'll nip out to watch support before getting ready. Iain & I always go on stage between bands to make sure the sequencers & samplers are all working properly & then it's showtime. Sometimes there are a few nerves but usually it's just a case of wanting to get on with it. And of course afterwards there's always a chance to meet people which is, more often than not, good fun. If there's a day off we usually go out into town somewhere if not it's back to the hotel for a minor brief unwinding session in someone's room before beddy bixes time - Ah well, so
