

As we know from the March issue, Jesus Jones have spent April and May hopping from state to state in the US and Canada. Your reports of the tour have been flying in to me from all over, conjuring up a picture of success and mass enjoyment! Thanks to all those who've sent me gig reviews, photos and other memorabilia which I'm putting together to make a kind of Spring '93 tour collage. One particular tale tells of a night in Seattle when a couple of gig goers had the sight of Jerry's butt hanging out of his dressing room window forced upon them!! Jerry obviously having some cause to prove his manhood? Yes. With his usual case of verbal diarrhoea, Iain has seen fit to fill up most of this issue with his US tour diary, so I'll let him fill you in on the rest.

After North America it was off to the East - Japan. The boys have just completed this leg of the tour, this time playing in Tokyo, Osaka, Nagoya and also a debut in Sapporo and Fukuoka. The band are staying on an extra week for promotional purposes (any excuse!) before heading off to Europe. A tour diary and Japanese discography will appear in Septembers issue.

The European dates consist mainly of festivals, including a one off....Shhhh....secret gig in the UK which has, no doubt, already been leaked to the music press. Full details inside. 



Oh No. When we came back on again i was convinced that the audience were applauding because i'd managed to hold on so well.

Detroit - we play in a Venue for too big
Columbus Ohio - we play in a Venue for too small.

Unsurprisingly the Second of these two is much better, it's like a riot with music.

Through Northampton we arrive in New York. New York is one of those places we can all let our hair (or wigs) down. So we do. Seriously. I spend Hours on the Slide at club USA which joins the upper and lower floors Jerry Goes on it once and Surgically removes large sections of Skin from His elbows. The New York Gig is Great (though im the only one who thinks so) Me and Alan Stay up all night on the Bus drive to Rhode

island, talking shit for the Olympics. Al got the Gold, I got silver. The Gig is Painful but a great way to get rid of a headache....

Philly - now there's a Rock'n'Roll Town....

(@ Spinal Tap) Me and Jerry are Attacked half way through "Right Here Right Now" by a huge wiggly bug thing with about 300 legs about ten feet long (oh okay - five inches) the crowd are treated to the dubious pleasure of seeing two grown rock musicians running off into the wings screaming.....

West Chester Uni (near Philly) is scene of some dubious crowd control tactics. The student security with all their vast knowledge of Molecular Biology and Astro physics are convinced that a thousand people can be held back using some of that "Police line-do not cross" tape. Somewhat Unsurprisingly their plan fails. oops.

In Norfolk we go shopping for silly hats
Eat fabulous food and do a blinding Gig ~ Same in Washington (minus the hats)
In Washington we visit Petes Grill, world famous Christian Burger Bar. Pete gets all un-Christian and starts waving a gun around to show us what he'd do if anybody ran

away without paying. We laugh loudly
and shit our pants silently.

Houston - the Audience makes more noise
than the Band (which takes some doing)
Great Gig.

Austin. Ho Hum. We've been booked into
a tiny gig with a terrible stage and weird
quasiroman decor. As a Latin Student
i feel duty bound to have a bad gig.
Everybody else joins me.

Normal, Illinois - we enter my favourite
state and reward the audience with a storming
gig - even my mistakes look great.

Eureka - Another Six flags. Band and crew
do the Ninja rollercoaster three times
Another "Attacked by insects" gig.

Chicago - the windy city! (Maybe that's why i
love it so much - parp.) Chicago is party town
#1 in the States and after a crazy gig
we go to Crobar and drink Zipperheads and
Mind Erasers until our minds are Zipped and
Erased. Me + Mike Stay overnight to fly
to Denver for Promotion and everyone else
Stagger onto the Bus for the 1000 mile
Journey.

Fayetteville - Al and Jerry get Gloriously sun
burned at the first sighting of the sun
and Glow onstage. Mikes Guitar does a
passable imitation of a broken down tractor
for most of the Gig. Onward to TEXAS!!
Dallas - we go off for a barbecue and Tasmin
archer turns up which is nice. We end up
at the 808 state Gig which is a bit cappy
and i decide to wave the white flag, having
drunk and ate far too much. Mike "Iron
Guts" Edwards now appears and heads
straight for Mexican food at two in the
morning.

We detour to L.A. to film the Arsenio
Hall show. Gen goes looking for the Star
Trek set but its closed. My New Silly Hat
gets its TV début. That night we fly
back to Phoenix. Its 56° when we leave
LAX, 105° when we land an hour later
Tempe - we top up our tons, Mike
hits the Mountain Bike trail and returns
with a strange T-shirt tan. Great gig

my keyboard and threatens to swallow me alive.
Back to LA! We have a dressing
room with a grand piano and a sunken

Bath!! The world and his wife appear at the after show but we haven't got time to say hello because we're straight off to San Fran.

San Fran is the Best Gig of the tour the Audience goes mad, so do we and a Barrage of inflated condoms invade the Stage during "real real real"

Sacramento. After Pausing for some photos at the Golden Gate we arrive in California's state capital which is a lot like Milton Keynes. Good gig in tiny theatre but it's been six days in a row and we're getting tired.

Vancouver. After an uneventful border crossing we finally arrive at our

the Gig is good - we do the encore in dressing gowns for reasons best known to ourselves.

Me + Jerry + Gen have a mad night at the Raving Dentist's house and look suitably ill on the plane home the next day. Six weeks of Madness. When's the next tour?


