Hello again peepes, how are we all then? Life at Jones Towers has been mega busy of late (and recently too) with ever increasing amounts of mail from all parts of the world pouring in.

By the time you read this, our heros will be on their world tour spreading the word of Jones and being International Bright Young Things! They are continuing what started back in February in the UK, until July when they return from Japan (see enclosed tour dates).

All this touring means that there isn't much time for new singles or another album, both of which will have to wait until December and January respectively. However, (as mentioned in the last issue), new material is constantly being worked on whilst on tour.

Everyone was amazed at the success of "Doubt" with at least 160,000 copies sold in the UK alone. It wasn't until the UK tour had sold out that the band realised just how big things were getting.

As usual, the tour had it's memorable events, like making the audience join in and sing the samples when Iain's keyboard packed up (have you seen how he treats it?!) in Cambridge, Mike's guitar smashing in Cardiff and having to push the transport to the Dublin gig in a foot of snow! The band's favourite gigs were those in Liverpool, Manchester, the first night in Birmingham and the second night at The Town & Country club in London.

Anyone who read Mike's Scandinavian tour diary which was published in the NME, will know that the European tour went well, despite the tonsillitis. By the time the band arrived in Switzerland, the fact that "Right Here, Right Now" had entered their top twenty was a pleasant surprise.

The promo tour of the USA in March was successful, with two packed out shows in San Francisco, as well as preparing the path for the tour proper. The album "Doubt" was number 1 for six weeks on every alternative and college chart and is climbing on the Billboard chart with 200,000 copies sold before the tour started. "Right Here, Right Now" and "International Bright Young Thing" are getting massive airplay on the radio and MTV and the US record company, SBK, are saying that Jesus Jones will be big news!

The band are looking forward to their first New Zealand visit, as well as returning to Australia and Japan. There is then the possibility of another USA tour in July/August, but a stint in the studio will be required as well - so it's going to be a busy old year!

Good News!!! At long last there is a video being released for sale on June 10th. Together with interviews and tour footage, it features 7 videos: Info Freako, Never Enough, Bring It On Down, Real, Real, Right Here, Right Now, International Bright Young Thing and Who? Where? Why?

Hot on the freels of their Number One album Doubt comes the first video from JESUS JONES: BIG IN ALASKA is released by PMI on 10 June:

This long-awaited video collection brings together the promos for all the band's singles none of which have failed to go Top 50. Running in chronological order BIG INALASKA kicks off with their startling debut Info Ereako (a £125 demo) and finishes with the most recent release. Who? Where? Why? which reached Number 21 in March

In between, there is 1989 sinever Enough and Bring It On Down from the Equidizer abum; the first Top 20 smash Real, Real; Right Here, Right Now and the band is biggest hit to date reaching Number Seven, International Bright Young Thing

The videos are introduced with humbrous clips of the band talking about each one, shot by lead singer and song writer Mike Edwards on his own video 8 camera at locations ranging from the Berlin Wall to Niagara Falls.

JESUS JUNES almost dety-classification; their powerful sound essentially fusing their energised rock, with a dance groove

In January this year their second album **Doubt** stormed into the charts at Number One, rapidly achieved. Goldstams and remained in the Top 20 for 10 weeks. The following month the band completed a self-our. UK tour before the first leg of their World Tour began in Europe.
